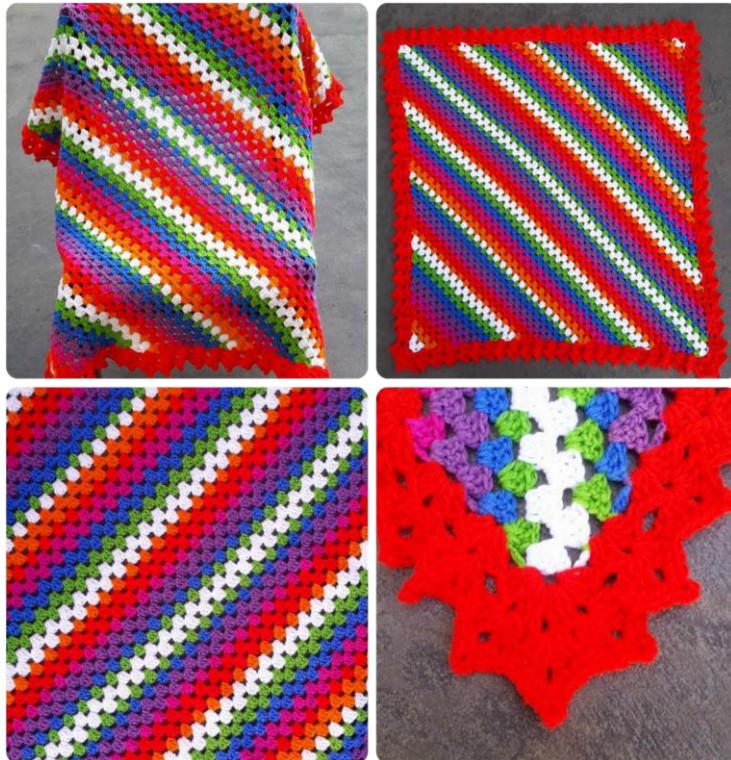


Corner to Corner Granny

US terms



Red heart super saver / 10ply

2 each 7 oz/200grams of Hot Red

1 each of 7 oz/200grams of White, Pumpkin, Shocking Pink, Medium Purple, Blue, Spring Green

5.5mm hook

Sewing needle and scissors

Afghan – Increase rows

I will list the colours at the end of the pattern that I used on my afghan

Chain 6 (this is one of your corners) and join with a slip stitch to the 1st chain Increasing rows

1. Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into ring, chain 1, double crochet into ring, turn
2. Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into chain 1 space, chain 1, 3 double crochet, chain 1 into last chain 1 space, double crochet in same space, turn
3. Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into chain 1 space, chain 1, 3 double crochet, chain 1 into next chain 1 space, 3 double crochet, chain 1 into last chain 1 space, double crochet in same space, turn

Each row you will gain an extra chain 1 space

4. Repeat row 3 until you have an **even** amount of rows the width you would like your square

Decreasing rows

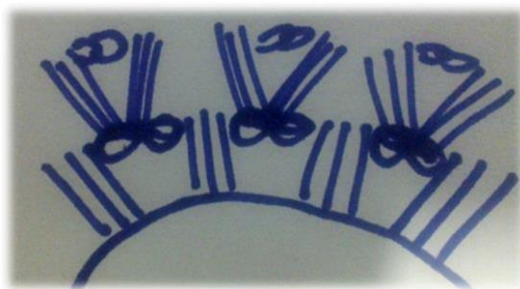
- Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet, chain 1 into the next chain 1 space and each chain 1 space across, 1 double crochet into the last chain 1 space, turn
- Repeat last row until you have 1 group of 3 double crochet left
- On last row – chain 4 and slip stitch into last space, finish off

Border

I know these are NOT good photos – but they really helped my testers to understand the instructions

MAKE SURE YOU READ THE WRITTEN DIRECTIONS ALSO

The first image is the first 2 rows of the corner – this is all added into the corner space



The next image is what we have on the straight – as you can see when we skip a space there is no chain 2 in-between



Border

Join new colour yarn in corner space

1. Chain 3 (2 double crochet, chain 2) (3 double crochet, chain 2) x 2, 3 double crochet into the same space, skip a space ** (3 double crochet, chain 2, 3 double crochet) into the next space, skip next space* repeat from ** to * across straight edge

Into the corner chain space (3 double crochet, chain 2) x 3, 3 double crochet into the same space, skip a space ** repeat from ** to ** around, slip stitch to top of chain 3 to join

2. Slip stitch across to chain 2 space, chain 3, (2 double crochet, chain 2, 3 double crochet) into the same chain 2 space * (3 double crochet, chain 2, 3 double crochet) into the next chain 2 space* repeat from * to * slip stitch to top of chain 3 to join

3. Slip stitch across to chain 2 space, Chain 1, 2 single crochet, chain 4, 2 single crochet into the same space, single crochet into the next 2 stitches, single crochet decrease over the next 2 stitches, single crochet into the next 2 stitches

(2 single crochet, chain 4, 2 single crochet) into the chain 2 space, single crochet into the next 2 stitches single crochet, decrease over the next 2 stitches, single crochet into the next 2 stitches repeat from * to * slip stitch to first single crochet. Finish off and sew in loose ends

Then I reversed the colours so I started at row 46 and worked back to row 1
