

## Spiral Beach bag

10 x 14 inch (very easy to adjust size)



4 colours of Red Heart Super Saver Worsted weight/10 ply yarn

Turqua 100 grams

Bright Yellow 60 grams

Pumpkin 60 grams

Spring Green 60 grams

5 mm hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

3 stitch markers

Multiple 4 +1

I chained 52+1 = 53

1. 2 hdc into second stitch from hook, hdc in each ch across, 3 dc into last ch, working on other side of foundation ch's, hdc in each ch across, slip stitch to the first stitch – 104 stitches
2. Divide your stitches by 4 – 104 divide 4 = 26  
Every 26 stitches place a stitch marker, you will have a piece of crochet that looks like the image below, the yarn that's still attached acts like one of your stitch markers

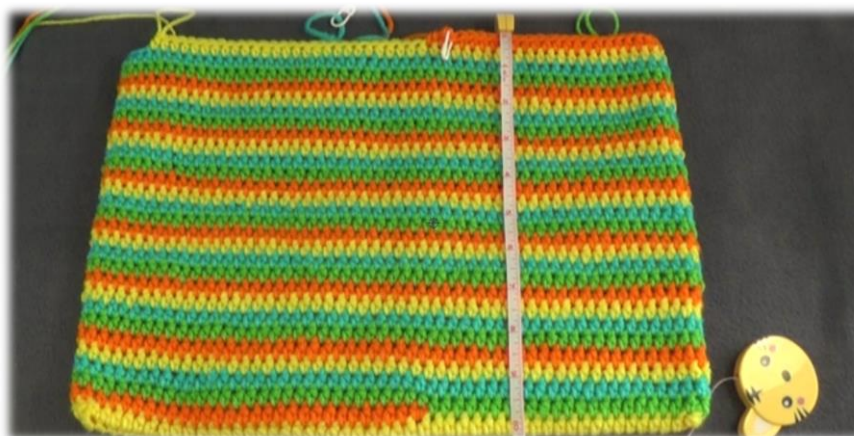

Ch 1, hdc into same stitch and each stitch until the stitch before the stitch marker \*join turqua into the marked stitch, put stitch marker into the colour you just finished to stop it unravelling, ch 1, sc into same stitch, hdc into each stitch until the stitch before the stitch marker\* repeat from \* to \* for green and orange DO NOT JOIN

3. Continuing with the orange hdc into each stitch until you get to the next stitch marker \*pick up yellow, hdc into each stitch, until you get to the next stitch marker\* repeat form \* to \* for each colour
4. Continue working with your yarns until you have the desired length – I did 10 inches / 25 cm

Finish each colour in the same spot it started – if you look at the image below you can see where the orange starts at the bottom of the bag and it lines up at the top of the bag



To finish off each colour, sc into next stitch, slip stitch into the next, finish off

Handle

1. Ch 5, hdc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, hdc in each ch, turn
2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into stitch as ch 1, hdc into each stitch
3. Repeat row 2 until your strap measures 80 inches / 2 meters
4. Making sure the handle is not twisted sew ends together
5. Sew handles to bag using photo as a guide

Pocket

1. Ch 25, hdc into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, hdc in each ch, turn
2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into inches / same stitch as ch 1, hdc into each stitch
3. Repeat row 2 until you have 25 rows

Sew in any loose ends
