

Crochet tool belt

Easy

Red Heart super saver- aran – 3.5 ounce / 100 grams

Red Heart super saver – turqua - small amount

4.5mm/g hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

3 stitch markers

Belt

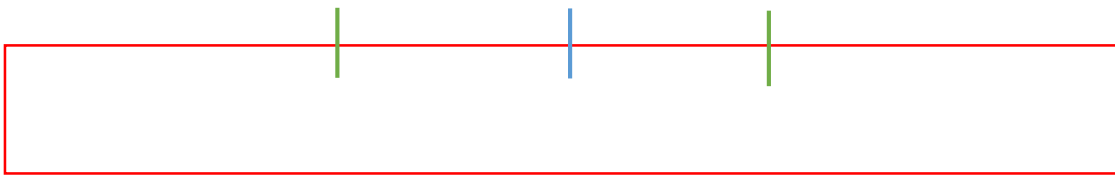
1. Chain 11, hdc into the 2nd ch from hook, hdc into each ch across, turn
2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into same stitch, hdc into each stitch across, turn
3. Repeat last round until you have the belt the length you need – I made mine 1 ½ times the length of the waist I needed it for

Apron

If possible measure from hip to hip on the person the tool belt is for

In the diagram below the green lines mark where the hips will be

Fold in half, put stitch marker at half way point (blue line) and measure (or count) the amount of stitches out towards the end of strap and place stitch marker (green line) do the same of the other end



1. Attach yarn at the green stitch marker on the right hand side, ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into same stitch, hdc into each stitch across to other green stitch marker, turn
2. You can remove all stitch markers. Repeat last row until you have the apron section the length you want, I did 13 rows. Fish off and sew in ends

Pockets

1. Ch 17, hdc into the 2nd ch from hook, hdc into each ch across, turn
2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into same stitch, hdc into each stitch across, turn
3. Repeat last row until you have a total of 16 rows
Leaving a 12 inch tail for sewing, finish off

Tab

1. Ch 15, , hdc into the 2nd ch from hook, hdc into each ch across, turn
2. Ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into same stitch, hdc into each stitch across, turn
3. Repeat last row, leaving a 12 inch tail for sewing, finish off

Using photo as a guide and contrast yarn, stitch around pockets

Attach pockets and tab to apron
