Red heart super saver

Baby newborn – Grey 30 grams / 1.1 oz

Baby 3-6 months - Grey 30 grams / 1.1 oz

Child- Deft blue 50 grams / 1.8 oz

Small adult – Turqua 90 grams / 3.2 oz

Medium adult – Turqua – 100 grams / 3.5 oz

Large adult – Blue 120grams / 4.3 oz

Extra larger – Grey Heather – 150 grams /  
4.8 oz

5.5 mm / I hook

Scissors

Yarn needle

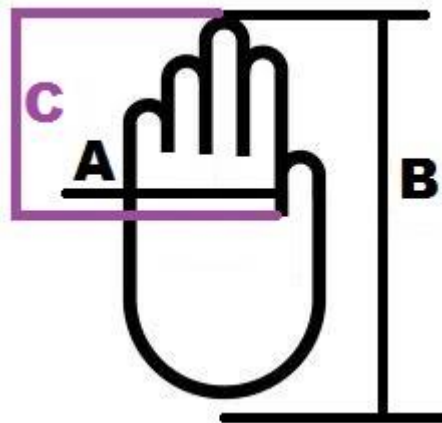
Tape measure

Stitch marker

Optional thin/shirring/hat elastic

Gauge: 7 cm x 7cm = 7 rows x 10 stiches

If you know the following measurement it will help with the fit of your gloves



Mittens are worked in a spiral, you will need to move your stitch marker up each round

Ribbing is worked on the round

Elastic can be added to the last round

Measurements are of the actual glove NOT hand

In the chart below the increase rows **INCLUDE** the first round

Increase rounds are worked different for each size

The following chart matches the written pattern, you can use this as a guide to make the perfect fit

Baby – Newborn	6.5 cm / 2.5 inch	8.5 cm / 3.5 inch	2	8	0	0	0	0	2
Baby 3-6 months	7 cm / 2 ¾ inch	8.5 cm / 3.5 inch	2	8	0	0	0	0	2
Child	8.5cm / 3 1/4 inch	5.5 inch	3	9	5	2	5	4	3
Small adult	9 cm / 3.5 inch	24 cm / 9.5 inch	3	14	9	2	7	7	6
Medium adult	10 cm / 4 inch	25 cm / 9.5 inch	4	14	9	2	7	7	6
Large adult	12 cm / 4 ¾ inch	27 cm / 10.5 inch	4	14	10	3	8	8	6
X large adult	14 cm / 5.5 inch	29 cm / 11.5 inch	4	14	10	3	8	8	6

### **Baby – grey**

1. Magic ring, (newborn size 8 half double) (3-6 month 9 half double crochet) into ring
2. 2 half double crochet into each stitch
- 3-7. 1 half double crochet into each stitch
8. 1 half double crochet into each stitch, single crochet in the second last and slip stitch into last stitch
9. \*Front post half double crochet around next stitch, back post half double crochet around next stitch\* repeat around, join to first stitch
10. Repeat round 9, finish off and sew in ends

### **Child– deft blue**

1. Magic ring, 9 half double crochet into the ring
2. 2 half double crochet in each stitch
3. \*1 half double crochet into the next stitch, 1 half double crochet into the next stitch, 2 half double crochet into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around
- 3-7. 1 half double crochet in each stitch
8. Chain 5, skip 2, half double crochet into each stitch around (see image below)

**\*\*Thumb hole example – you may have different amount of chains or stitches skipped**



- 9-10. 1 half double crochet in each stitch/chain around
11. 1 half double crochet into each stitch, single crochet in the second last and slip stitch into last stitch

12. \*Front post half double crochet around next stitch, back post half double crochet around next stitch\* repeat around, join to first stitch
- 13-14. Repeat round 12, finish off and sew in ends

### **Thumb**

1. Attach yarn in any stitch of thumb, half double crochet into each stitch
2. Half double crochet into each stitch
3. Repeat round 2
- 4-5. Decrease every second stitch, finish off with a 6 inch tail, gather end of thumb and sew in ends

### **Small/medium adult - turqua**

1. Make a Magic ring, (small – 8 half double crochet) (medium - 9 half double crochet) into the ring
2. 2 half double crochet in each stitch
3. \*Half double crochet into the next stitch, 2 half double crochet into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around.
- 4-15. 1 half double crochet into each stitch.
16. Chain 9, skip 2 stitches, half double crochet into the next, half double crochet around (see image below)

**\*\*Thumb hole example – you may have different amount of chains or stitches skipped**



- 17-21. Half double crochet into each stitch/chain around.
22. Half double crochet into each stitch until 2 stitches from end, single crochet into next stitch, slip stitch into next stitch

23. \*Front post half double crochet around next stitch, back post half double crochet around next stitch\* repeat around, join to first stitch

24. Repeat round 23 for 8 rounds or until desired length, finish off sew in ends

### **Thumb**

1-5. Attach yarn and half double crochet around the opening

6-7. Half double crochet into next stitch, half double crochet decrease into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around. Leaving a 6 inch tail finish off and gather end. Sew in ends

### **Large adult - blue/XL adult – Grey**

1. Make a Magic ring (large 8 half double crochet) (XL - 9 half double crochet) into the ring

2. 2 half double crochet in each stitch

3. \*Half double crochet into the next stitch, 2 half double crochet into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around.

4. \*1 half double crochet into the next stitch, 1 half double crochet into the next stitch, 2 half double crochet into the next stitch \* \* repeat from \* to \* around.

5-15. 1 half double crochet in each stitch

16. Chain 10 skip 3 stitches, half double crochet around (see image below)

**\*\*Thumb hole example – you may have different amount of chains or stitches skipped**



17. Half double crochet in each stitch/chain around

18-23. Half double crochet in each stitch

24. Half double crochet into each stitch until 2 stitches from end, single crochet into next stitch, slip stitch into next stitch

25. \*Front post half double crochet around next stitch, back post half double crochet around next stitch\* repeat around, join to first stitch

26. Repeat round 25 for 8 rounds or until desired length

### **Thumb**

1-5. Attach yarn and half double crochet around the opening

6-7. Half double crochet into next stitch, half double crochet decrease into next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* around. Leaving a 6 inch tail finish off and gather end. Sew in ends
