US terms

Red heart super saver medium worsted weight yarn

5.5 mm / I hook

Scissors

Yarn needle

### **Increase rows**

Chain 4 (this is one of your corners) and join with a slip stitch to the 1<sup>st</sup> chain

1. Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into ring, chain 1, double crochet into ring, turn
  2. Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into chain 1 space, chain 1, 3 double crochet, chain 1 into last chain 1 space, double crochet in same space, turn
  3. Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into chain 1 space, chain 1, 3 double crochet, chain 1 into next chain 1 space, 3 double crochet, chain 1 into last chain 1 space, double crochet in same space, turn
- Each row you will gain an extra chain 1 space

4. Repeat row 3 until you have the width you would like your rectangle scarf/afghan

### **Straight sides**

**I will no longer be numbering rows as we may have a different amount**

- Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet, chain 1 into the **next** chain 1 space and each chain 1 space across, (3 double crochet, chain 1, 1 double crochet) into the last chain 1 space, turn
- Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) 3 double crochet into **same** chain 1 space, chain 1 (3 double crochet, chain 1) into next chain 1 space, 1 double crochet into the last chain 1 space, turn
- Repeat last 2 steps until you have the length you want your scarf/afghan

### **Decreasing rows**

- Chain 4 (counts as double crochet and chain 1) (3 double crochet, chain 1) into the next chain 1 space and each chain 1 space across, 1 double crochet into the last chain 1 space, turn
- Repeat last row until you have 1 group of 3 double crochet left
- On last row – chain 4 and slip stitch into last space

### **Border**

- Chain 1, 3 single crochet into each space across and 5 single crochet into the corner spaces. Work around and slip stitch to the first chain 1 to join.
- **Optional**- chain 1, single crochet into each stitch around – if you find the corners are bending in put 2 single crochet into 1 or 2 of the corner stitches
- Finish off and sew in ends
