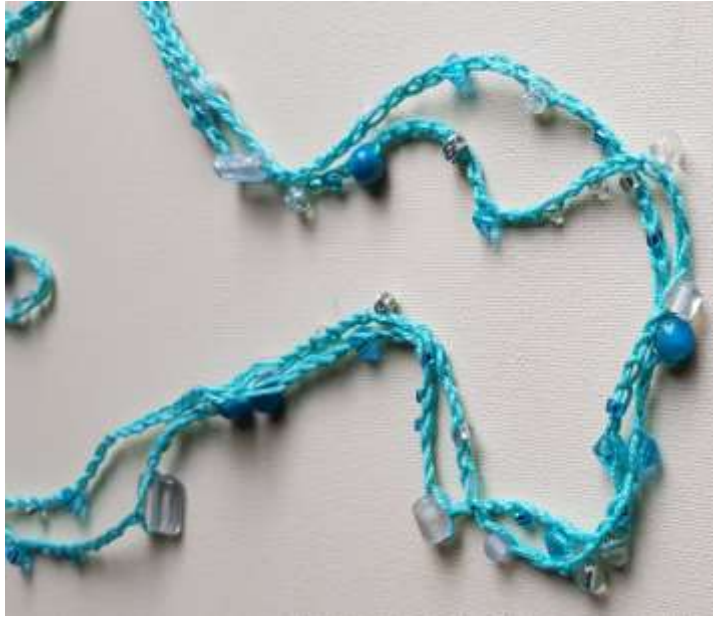
Necklace size 2 meter circle

Supplies

Fingering weight cotton

Approx. 70 beads, more if you want your necklace longer

Needle for threading beads onto cotton



Thread all of your beads onto your cotton in the order that you want them to be displayed
Push most of the beads across so that you have about 40 cm of bare thread

1. Ch3, *pull a bead across so that it is snug up against your stitch, complete a ch stitch, the bead should now be captured in the ch, ch4* repeat from * to * until you have used up all of your beads. To mix things up, change the amount of chains you do in between the beads. If it is a small bead, do less chains either side. If it is a larger bead make more chains either side
2. Finish with a ch3, slip stitch to the first ch to join OR finish off and sew in your ends
