

# CROCHET I CORD NECKLACE



Crochet Icord Necklace

Supplies - yarn and 1 size smaller than recommended crochet hook



Tip: to tighten the icord, pull up on 2nd loop on hook and then pull 3rd loop as you work.

1. Ch 3, go into 2nd ch from hook and pull up loop, go into 3rd ch and pull up a loop. Remove 1st two loops from hook (closest to the tip of the hook) and hold them. Hang on tight because they will try to get away on you
2. Ch 1, put next loop you're holding back on hook, ch 1, put last loop you're holding back on hook, ch 1. You should end up with 3 loops on your hook.

NOTE it is easier to add or take away stitches after you have decided how big you want your chain section  
I completed the necklace before I finished off so I could see if I needed to make my icord shorter or longer

Repeat steps 1 & 2 until you reach the desired length.

Decide how long you want the unchained part of your necklace, then tie a slip knot and make as many chains as you want

Yarn over and pull through all 3 loops to fasten off. Weave in ends.
