Red Heart super saver yarn

5.5mm / I hook

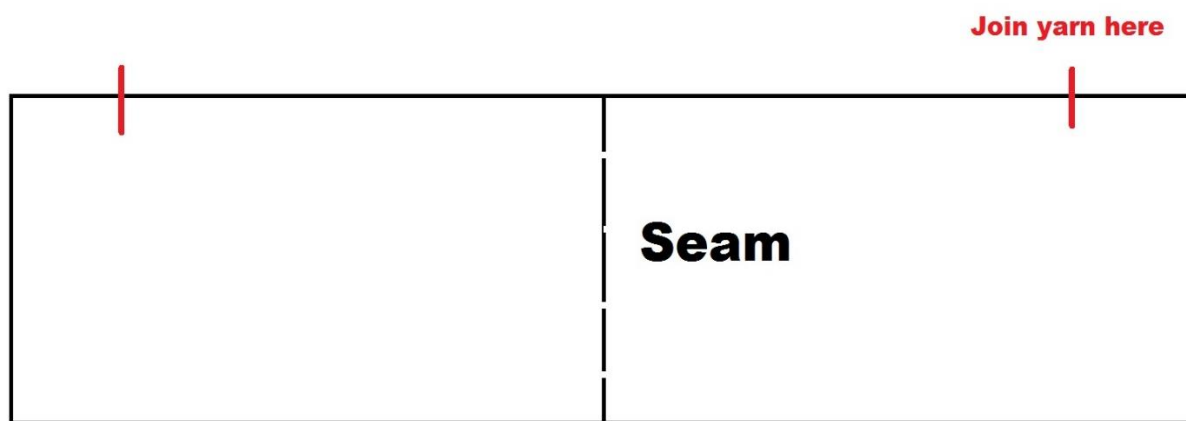
Stitch marker

Scissors

Yarn needle

1. Chain 10 (chain more if you want a wider headband) hdc into the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook and each chain across, turn
2. Chain 1 (does not count as a stitch) hdc into the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch and each stitch across, turn
3. Repeat row 2 until you have the length that you need – my head measurement is 58 cm and I made my headband 47 cm to allow for stretching. Leaving a 15-20cm tail, finish off

Sew short ends together



Lay headband flat – make sure sewn seam is in the centre (see image)

Place stitch marker on left red marker (see image)

Using 2 strands of yarn join yarn 1 ½ inches in from right hand edge (see image)

1. Chain 1, hdc into the same stitch, 1 hdc in the next stitch, \*2 hdc into the next stitch, 1 hdc into the next 2 stitches \* repeat across to stitch marker (stitch marker is a guide on where to stop) ending with 1 hdc into the next 2 stitches, slip stitch into the next stitch, turn
2. Chain 1, skip 1st stitch (slip stitch from previous row) and hdc in every stitch across, when you reach the end of the row you will half double crochet into the next available stitch on the headband, slip stitch in the next stitch, turn
3. Chain 1, skip 1st stitch (slip stitch from previous row) and hdc into the next stitch, 1 hdc in the next stitch, \*2 hdc into the next stitch, 1 hdc into the next 2 stitches \* repeat across, when you reach the end of the row you will hdc into the side of row 1, hdc into the next available stitch on the headband, slip stitch in the next stitch, turn
4. Chain 1, skip 1st stitch (slip stitch from previous row) and hdc in every stitch across, when you reach the end of the row you will half double crochet into the side of row 1, hdc into the next available stitch on the headband, slip stitch in the next stitch, turn
5. Repeat 3 and 4 twice more and finish off and sew in ends
