

## Golf club covers

Red Heart super saver

Spring green 5 oz

White 2 oz

5.5 mm / I hook

6 mm / J hook

Gauge

First 4 rounds of the pattern – Circles diameter is 11 cm

## Cover - 1 wood

With 5.5 mm / I hook, spring green make a magic ring OR chain 4 and join to the first chain with a slip stitch

1. 12 half double crochet, join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
2. Chain 1, 1 half double crochet into the same stitch, 2 half double crochet into each stitch, join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
3. Chain 1, Half double crochet into the same stitch, 2 half double crochet into the next stitch \* half double crochet into the next stitch, 2 half double crochet into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
4. Chain 1, half double crochet into the same stitch, half double crochet into the next, 2 half double crochet into next \* half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet into the next, 2 half double crochet into next\* \* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
- 5-10. Chain 1, half double crochet into each stitch, join with a slip stitch to the first half double crochet

### Decrease rounds

11. Chain 1, half double crochet into the same stitch, half double crochet into next stitch, half double crochet **decrease** into the next stitch, \*half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet decrease into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
12. Chain 1, half double crochet into the same stitch, half double crochet decrease into the next \*half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet decrease into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
- 13-14. Chain 1, Half double crochet in each stitch, join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet

### Ribbing

15. Change to 6 mm / J hook, chain 1 \*front post half double crochet around the first stitch, back post half double crochet around the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet

Repeat round 15 until desired length, finish off and sew in ends

With white, surface slip stitch on rounds 5 and 10



#### **Patch**

- Follow rounds 1-3 from cover, leave a long tail (12 inches) for sewing to cover
- Weave a strand of yarn in and out of the stitch holes (where you would normally put your crochet hook)
- For the number, chain 10 and finish off with a long tail and stitch to patch

#### **Cover – 3 wood**

With 5.5 mm / I hook, spring green make a magic ring OR chain 4 and join to the first chain with a slip stitch

1. 12 half double crochet, join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
2. Chain 1, 1 half double crochet into the same stitch, 2 half double crochet into each stitch, join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
3. Chain 1, Half double crochet into the same stitch, 2 half double crochet into the next stitch \* half double crochet into the next stitch, 2 half double crochet into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
4. Chain 1, half double crochet into the same stitch, half double crochet into the next, 2 half double crochet into next \* half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet into the next, 2 half double crochet into next\* \* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet, finish off and sew in ends

#### **Change to white**

- 5-10. 6 rounds half double crochet

### Decrease rounds

Change back to spring green

11. Chain 1, half double crochet into the same stitch, half double crochet into next stitch, half double crochet **decrease** into the next stitch, \*half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet decrease into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
12. Chain 1, half double crochet into the same stitch, half double crochet decrease into the next \*half double crochet into the next stitch, half double crochet decrease into the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet
- 13-14. Chain 1, half double crochet into each stitch, join with a slip stitch to the first half double crochet

### Ribbing

15. Change to 6 mm / J hook, chain 1 \*front post half double crochet around the first stitch, back post half double crochet around the next stitch\* repeat from \* to \* join with a slip stitch into the first half double crochet

Repeat round 15 until desired length, finish off and sew in ends

With white, surface slip stitch on rounds 5 and 10

### Patch

Using white

- Follow rounds 1-3 from cover, leave a long tail (12 inches) for sewing to cover
- Using spring green surface slip stitch around the stitches of the round 3
- For the number placement I used the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the patch for a guide to keep my number as close to even as possible – see image
- For the number, chain about 30 - I left my yarn attached and used a separate length of yarn to stitch the number on, if I needed less or more chains for the number I adjusted it as needed



## **Cover 5 wood**

Follow instructions for the 1 wood ignoring the surface slip stitching

### **Patch**

Using white

- Follow rounds 1-3 from cover, leave a long tail (12 inches) for sewing to cover
- Using spring green slip stitch into round 3's front loops only
- For the number 5 I chained 25 – I also used round 2 as a guide to get it straight
