US terminology

400-600 grams of Red Heart super saver and a 6mm/J hook OR
400-600 grams of 8ply/DK and a 5mm/H hook

- Tight tension is necessary
- Project is made holding 2 strands at once
- Note: The pattern is worked in the round and not joining after each row

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Ch 4, slip stitch into first ch to make a ring OR make a magic ring

1. Ch 1, 8 sc into the ring, DO NOT JOIN, insert stitch marker into last sc just made
2. 2 sc into first sc, 2 sc in each stitch around until you reach the stitch marker, move stitch marker up
3. *1 sc into next stitch, 2 sc into the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around until you reach your stitch marker. Ending with 2 sc in same stitch, rounds ALWAYS end on an increase, Move your stitch marker up.
4. *1 sc into next 2 stitches, 2 sc into the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around until you reach your stitch marker, move your stitch marker up.
5. *1 sc into next 3 stitches, 2 sc into the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around until you reach your stitch marker, move your stitch marker up
6. *1 sc into next 4 stitches, 2 sc into the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around until you reach your stitch marker, move your stitch marker up
7. *1 sc into next 5 stitches, 2 sc into the next stitch* Repeat from * to * around until you reach your stitch marker, move your stitch marker up
8. NOTE: You will continue to increase each row until you have the size desired for your base.
9. Each row will have 1 more sc in-between the 2 HDC's
10. Once you have the base of your basket the width you need
11. 1 sc in each stitch around. Continue to move your stitch marker up with each round until the side of the basket are **DOUBLE** is the desired height.

In last stitch, SC and then SL ST across the next 2 stitches for a nice finish. Fasten off and sew in tail

Fold down the side of the basket, you can stitch in place if desired
