



Crochet spiral cowl

US terminology

Main colour - 7 oz/198 grams Red Heart Super Saver Light grey

Contrast colour - 5 oz/141grams Parrot stripe Red Heart Super Saver stripes

8mm crochet hook

Stitch marker (optional) scissors and a yarn needle

You can use a foundation sc instead of the chains

This project is worked into a spiral

With the main colour make a chain that is 24 inches long and an even amount of stitches. Being careful not to twist the chain, join with a slip stitch to the first ch

1. Sc in each st around, DO NOT JOIN

2. Single crochet into the first sc, pull up a loop and take out your hook POINT A on pic

Lay your work flat and join yarn on the opposite side of your cowl POINT B on pic

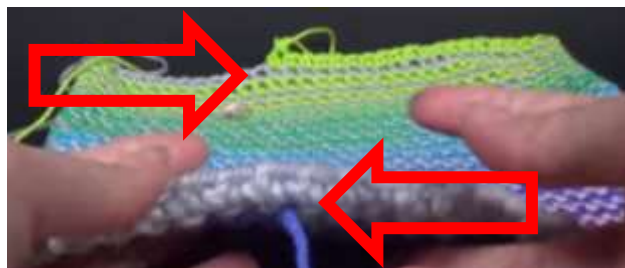
Sc around until you are 2 stitches from MC (main colour)

With MC sc around to CC (contrast colour)

Single crochet around, each time you get to the other colour pick it up and crochet around



When you have your cowl the length you want, finish the CC with a slip stitch in the same spot that you started - see image



- With MC , work 2 rounds of sc, finish off in same spot as the CC, slip stitch into the next ch 1, sc in each stitch around, JOIN with a slip stitch work 1 more round of SC, finish off and sew in your ends
