2 x 7oz/200 gram Red Heart Super Saver worsted weight yarn

K – 6.5mm hook

Yarn needle

Scissors

Stitch marker

This pattern is made in a spiral and you will NOT join the rounds

You will be placing the stitch marker into the 1st stitch of each round

This pattern is made using 2 strands at once

1. Magic ring or Ch 4 and join with a slip stitch to the first stitch, ch 1 (does not count as a stitch) 12 hdc into ring DO NOT JOIN
2. 1 hdc (place stitch marker into this stitch) 1 hdc into same stitch, 2 hdc into each stitch round, stopping at the stitch before the marker
3. 1 hdc into next stitch (place stitch marker into this stitch) 2 hdc into next stitch* 1 hdc into next stitch, 2 hdc into next stitch* repeat from * to * around
4. 1 hdc into next stitch (place stitch marker into this stitch) 1 hdc into next stitch, 2 hdc into next stitch* 1 hdc into next 2 stitches, 2 hdc into next stitch* repeat from * to * around
I will not tell you to move the stitch marker anymore 😊
5. *1 hdc into the next 3 stitches, 2 hdc into next stitch* repeat from * to * around
6. *1 hdc into the next 4 stitches, 2 hdc into next stitch* repeat from * to * around
7. *1 hdc into the next 5 stitches, 2 hdc into next stitch* repeat from * to * around
8. *1 hdc into the next 6 stitches, 2 hdc into next stitch* repeat from * to * around
9. 1 hdc into each stitch
10. Repeat round 9 until you have the body of the basket the size you desire did 20 rows – at the end of row finish with a sc in next stitch and a slip stitch into the next stitch

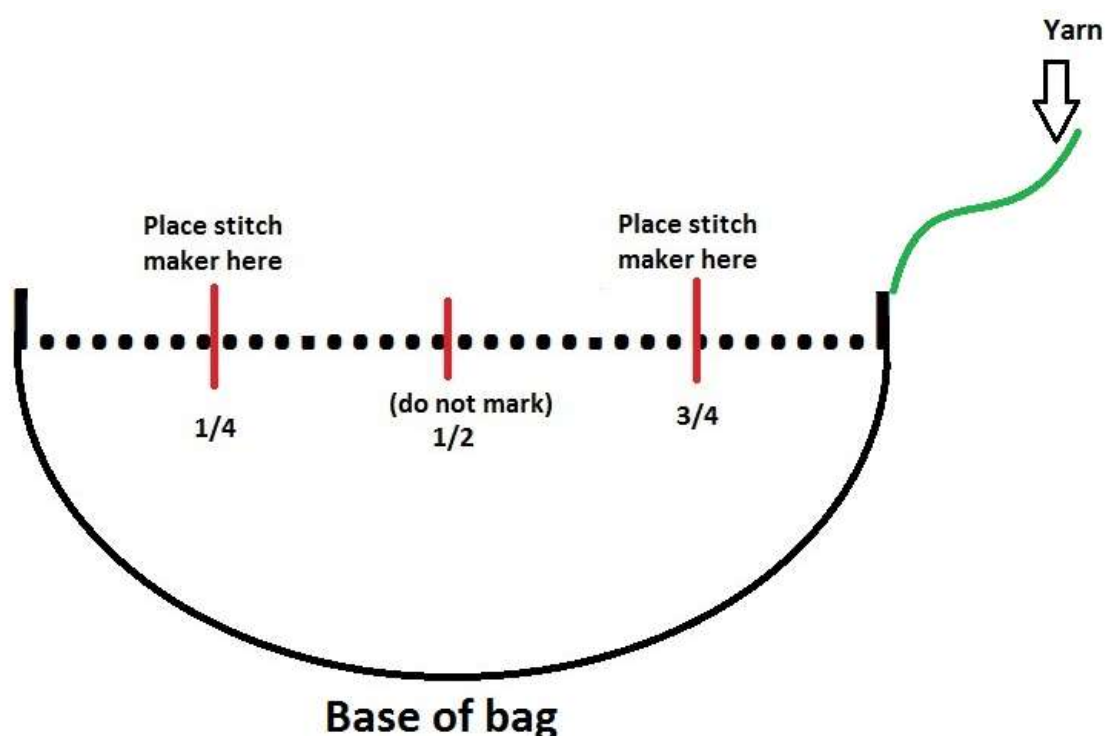
Change to contrast colour

Ch 1 (ch 1 does not count as a stitch) sc into same stitch, sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to the first sc

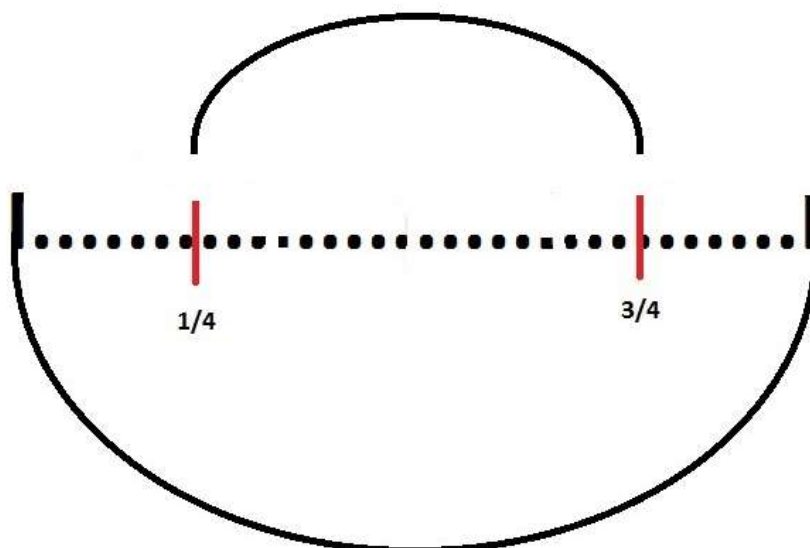
Change back to main colour

Ch 1 (ch 1 does not count as a stitch) sc into same stitch, sc into each stitch around, join with a slip stitch to the first sc

Repeat last round for desired length – I did 5 rows



We do NOT crochet inbetween these markers



Handles

Lay bag flat so that your yarn is on the right hand side (see diagram) *if you are left handed this will be on the left*
Place stitch markers as shown in diagram, spread the stitch makers out evenly

Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc across to the 1st stitch marker, ch (I had skipped 17 stitches and ch 25, if you want your handles longer, ch more, you need to remember this number) sc into the next marked stitch, sc around until next stitch marker, ch the same amount you did for the first handle, sc into next marked stitch, sc around., join with a slip stitch to the first sc

Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc in each stitch around, when you get to the ch, sc into the back bump of ch's

Ch 1, sc into same stitch, sc into each stitch around, join to first sc with a slip stitch

Repeat last round for 3 rounds

With contrast colour slip stitch around the outside edge of top of bag and also the inside edge of handles
