

# The Natalie crochet cowl or scarf

US terminology  
Easy+

[2 x Red Heart Ombra](#) Medium worsted weight  
yarn / 10 ply / Aran  
8.00 mm / L hook for a nice drape  
Scissors  
Yarn needle

ch – chain  
dc – double crochet  
inc – increase  
dec - decrease



## Notes:

Each row starts **and** ends with an **inc** (2 dc into the same stitch) this helps the sides stay straight

**NOTE:** Only repeat what is in between the ( )

1. Chain multiple of 16 + 2 ch (I did 34 ch's)  
dc into the 3rd ch  
\*1 dc into the next 5 ch's  
(dec over the next 2 ch) x2  
dc into the next 5 ch's  
dc inc into the next 2 ch's\*  
Repeat from \* to \* across ending with 1 dc in next 5 stitches, inc in last stitch, turn

**NOTE:** Only repeat what is in between the ( )

2. Ch3, dc into same stitch  
\*(ch1, skip 1 stitch, dc into next stitch) x2  
ch1, skip 1 (dec into the next 2 stitches) x2  
(ch1, skip 1, dc in next) x2  
ch1, skip 1, (inc into the next 2 stitches) x 2\*  
repeat from \* to \* across ending with 2 dc into the last stitch

**NOTE:** Chain spaces **are** counted as stitches

3. Ch 3, dc into the same stitch as the ch 3  
\*1 dc into the next 5 stitches  
(dec into the next 2 stiches) x 2 - the first part of the first dec starts in the ch space, the second half of the second dec ends in a ch space  
dc into the next 5 stiches  
dc inc into the next 2 stitches\*  
Repeat from \* to \* across ending with 1 dc in next 5 stitches, inc in last stitch, turn

Repeat row 2 and 3 until desired length

- ♥ If you are making the scarf, wrap or blanket finish with row 3
- ♥ Scarf continue until you run out of yarn
- ♥ Cowl 66 rows and finish with row 2  
Leave about a 10 inch tail for sewing first and last row together
